

Pupil Premium Funding

Registering for free school meals could raise money for your child's school

From September 2014 all children who are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 will be offered a free healthy school lunch.

However, it's important for any qualifying family (see below) to still sign up for free school meals as registering could also raise an extra £1,320 for your child's school from central government, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, learning assistants or after school clubs.



Even if you don't want your child to receive a free meal, we would encourage you to register for free school meals so their school receives as much funding as possible.

Your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding if you get any of the following:



- Income support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit
