Friday, 1st December

In return for the children not wearing their uniforms, the FPTA are asking for donations towards their 'Rainbow Raffle'. Once received, the FPTA will make up colour-themed hampers from the donations. Each class has a colour to work to, some examples / ideas are given below:

Reception – PINK:	Pink body wash, pink body puff, pink sweets, anything that's in a pink bottle, Rosé wine, marshmallows, etc.
Year 1 – YELLOW:	Lemon body wash, Limoncello, lemon curd, lemonade, tin of sweetcorn, popcorn etc.
Year 2 – BLUE:	Something blueberry flavoured, sweets in blue wrappers, a blue toothbrush and toothpaste etc.
Year 3 – WHITE:	White chocolate items, soaps and body wash, white bread mix, tin of new potatoes, etc.
Year 4 – GREEN:	Matchmaker chocolates, jar of lime pickle, mint club biscuits, etc.
Year 5 – PURPLE:	Most Cadbury's chocolate items, toiletries with purple packaging, something lavender smelling, etc.
Year 6 – RED:	Tomato-based sauces, tin of tomatoes, red wine, mulled wine, etc.

Some of the suggestions for other colours will likely apply to your class colour too! Note these are just suggestions.
